

NTI Days

Dear Parents,

It is time to prepare for **Non-Traditional Instructional Days**. When you receive the One-Call from school instructing you that it is a **Non-Traditional Instructional Day**, your child will be required to complete the work assigned in a packet or through Study Island. We will be communicating information about NTI Days through Remind, so please sign up for text messages if you have not already.

The third grade teachers have created assignments for three NTI Days. Your child will complete all work for NTI Days through Study Island. Your child's teacher will make the assignments active if there is an NTI Day. If you do not have Internet and/or computer access, we will provide a printed copy of the Study Island assignment in this envelope.
