

Dear Parents,

It is time to prepare for Non-Traditional Instructional (NTI) Days. When you receive the One-Call from school instructing you that it is a NTI Day, your child will be required to complete the work assigned in a packet or through Study Island. We will be communicating information about NTI Days through Remind/Class Dojo, so please make sure you are signed up to receive messages.

The fifth grade teachers have created assignments for three NTI Days. Your child must complete all work through Study Island. Your child's teacher will make the assignments active when a NTI Day is announced. If you do not have Internet and/or computer access, a paper packet of the Study Island assignments has been provided in this envelope. Here is a list of the Study Island assignments:

Math	Multiplying Whole Numbers - 2e
Social Studies	Native Americans - 5c

Your child is to return the packet or complete the Study Island assignments in order to receive credit for attendance. Please keep the envelope in a safe, secure place (like on the refrigerator) so that you will have access to the NTI Day procedures and assignments. Also, please note that **EVERY STUDENT** is required to complete any assigned NTI Day work.
