

Advanced Placement (AP) Exams

FEE: \$90.00 per exam

REGISTRATION/SIGN UP: Counseling Office

DEADLINE: Sign-up and payment of registration fees must be done by March 20, 2014. Payment must be made at the time of registration.

FREE OR REDUCED LUNCH WAIVER: If you qualify for Free or Reduced lunch, your parents must sign a release of information document in order for the Counseling Office to release this information to College Board (the testing service for AP Exams). If your parents/guardians have not signed this form they need to see Margie McDavid at Russell High School. (All funding for testing is dependent on Congress and/or the state legislature.) *As of this year, Free and Reduced lunch students must pay \$20.00/test.**

CANCELLING EXAM PROCESSING FEE: If you register for an AP Exam and the material is ordered and you decide not to take the exam, a processing fee of \$20.00 will be retained. You will only receive a refund of \$70.00.

KENTUCKY EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE

SCHOLARSHIP (KEES): If you are enrolled in an AP class and you choose not to take the AP Exam, the title of the course will be changed to Honors on your RHS transcript. The Honors class will be weighted for your Russell High School GPA and rank in class. Honors classes do not apply toward your KEES money.

ON-LINE PREPARATION: Please contact the AP class teacher concerning the information about on-line preparation websites. This information was sent to all AP teachers.

Advance Kentucky will reimburse \$40.50 for each exam taken in English, math and science. Additionally, Advance Kentucky will reward students \$100.00 who score 3 or above on tests in English, math and science. (\$100 for each test)
