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POLICY TOPIC DESCRIPTION
Math Facts Policy
This policy is to ensure the practice of math facts in each grade level in order to improve fluency.

POLICY STATEMENT
<p>Students will practice fact fluency on a daily basis. (This will be need-based. Students may be working on addition, subtraction, multiplication or division.) Math Fact Awards and a celebration will be provided each year for students who have mastered their math multiplication facts. In order for a student to be eligible to receive the award and participate in the math fact celebration that is held at the end of each year, he/she must demonstrate the following expectations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Receive instruction in 3rd or 4th-grade content. (Fifth-grade students should have already mastered their multiplication facts.)● Fourth-Grade: Pass a 100 fact multiplication assessment in 5 minutes or under with 90% accuracy.● Third-Grade: Pass a 50 fact multiplication assessment in 5 minutes or under with 90% accuracy.
